Prior announcement of the presidential results

- Residents remain calm. The majority are awaiting the presidential results. Others are in a celebratory mood as they envision a win for their preferred candidate.

After announcement of the presidential results

- Youths began stealing from fellow residents. Shops are closed.
- Chaos has erupted in the area and there are reports alleging some residents have been killed.

Prior announcement of the presidential results

Prior announcement of the presidential results
